

**Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees

October 18, 2021**

At a regular meeting of the Aspermont Independent School District Board of Trustees held on October 18, 2021 members Jared Bell, Bay Hecht, Brandon Criswell, Dana Berry, Ray Bradley, Jennifer Hodges, and Lorenzo Calamaco were present along with Superintendent Zach Morris. Charla Leonard, Jaxon Hodges, Anya Mullen, Jeff Hurt, Trent and Shasta Van Meter, Tiffany Potts, Ashley and Hadlee Bell, and Melva Rojas were also in attendance.

Meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m with Mr. Van Meter leading the invocation and Jared Bell leading the pledges.

No one addressed the Board in an open forum.

The campus principal's recognized the 'Hornet Strong' student and staff of the month to begin the meeting. Mr. Van Meter recognized Hadlee Bell from the third grade and Mrs. Shasta Van Meter, second grade teacher. Mrs. Potts recognized Jaxon Hodges, sixth grader, as student of the month. Melva Rojas was recognized as the secondary staff member of the month.

Bay Hecht made a motion to approve the minutes from September 20, 2021. Motion was seconded by Ray Bradley. All in favor.

Motion was made by Ray Bradley to approve the bills from October. Bay Hecht seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Cross Country was successful with all runners advancing to Regionals. Practice UIL congress meet and Senior volleyball night are coming up, as well as the District FFA meet.

Superintendent Morris addressed the board regarding budget and investment reports up to date, 18% of revenues has been received while only 11% has been spent. The Fall Festival went well with a big turnout. Hornet Council has a community clean up day planned and Thanksgiving meal will be November 17, 2021.

Brandon Criswell made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Lorenzo Calamaco. All in favor.

The meeting adjourned at 6:58 p.m.
